### Wear Purple for Epilepsy Awareness Day

On **Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> May** the school will be holding a 'Wear Purple' day for Epilepsy awareness. The National Day was held earlier in the year, but it is never too late to jump on board! We currently have multiple members of our Community who are dealing with Epilepsy so we will use this opportunity to raise awareness and understanding. More information to come as the date approaches.

'Epilepsy is a disorder of the brain, and seizures are caused by a temporary disruption of the electrical activity in the brain. Epilepsy is diagnosed when someone has a tendency to have recurrent seizures.

Approximately 3% to 3.5% of Australians will be diagnosed with epilepsy at some point in their lives and over 250,000 Australians currently live with epilepsy.

Epilepsy can start at any age although it is more likely to be diagnosed in childhood or senior years.

There are many different types of epilepsies and people's experiences differ greatly. Some types of epilepsy are age-limited and the person eventually stops having seizures. For others, epilepsy is a life-long condition.' (www.epilepsy.org.au)


